WINE APPRECIATION AND EDUCATION

This new activity group is targeted at members who are interested in learning about and exploring the Texas Hill Country Wine Region.

- The group will initially meet 4 times during the Newcomers' calendar year on a weekday.
- Participating Lakeway Newcomers will visit local wineries for tastings that include wine and winery education.
- Wine tastings will be led by the winery's personnel.
- Participating members will be responsible for their own transportation and carpooling will be encouraged.
- The group's chairpersons will explore the availability of cheese pairings and/or food options for each outing.
- Costs for each event will be the individual responsibility of the participating member and will be collected prior to the event.
- The target fee for events will be around \$25 per person.
- Initially, the attendance for each event will be limited to the first 30 members who send in their event payment.


