## A Word of Caution

We all have become aware of scams that use email to steal our private information or that try to get us to send a scammer money. One of the scams that is targeting membership organizations, such as the Newcomers, is an email that pretends to be from the club's president. We know of several other Austin membership organizations who have been targeted with this scam. Earlier, we notified our membership of an instance of this scam, and we just learned that the culprit has returned for a second round.

Please know that a Lakeway Newcomers board member will never solicit money or gift cards from our members. If you get an email asking for money or gift cards for what may appear to be a good cause this should be an immediate red flag that the email is a scam. When you view the actual email address, behind the supposed board member's name, you will likely find a strange address. In the most recent case that email address is uchennao@tippinpt.com.

If you receive this type of scam email, your best course of action is to block the sender and delete the email. Never reply to a suspicious message that asks for money or personal information.
