A Country Western dinner and dance social will be held jointly with the Newcomers Alumni group on Thursday, September 22.



# Brews and Booze Experiences



The date and location for our inaugural Newcomers Brews and Booze Experiences event will be on **Thursday, October 6 between 4:00 and 6:00 PM at Beerburg.** Beerburg is located about 15 miles southwest of Lakeway.

Beerburg is locally owned with family ties to Lakeway. They offer a mix of on-site developed brews and a South Texas inspired taqueria -- with both indoor and expansive outdoor seating.

For the \$25 price of this event, we have arranged a flexible choice of beverage options to accommodate individual attendee preferences. For those who want to try a broader range of beers, there is a 4-beer flight option. There's an option for those who would prefer two larger pint-sized beers. And for those attending with partners who prefer wine over beer, there is an option for two glasses of wine. Additionally, Beerburg will provide some light appetizers and a group tour of the brewery.

# Membership and New Members

The Lakeway Newcomers Board recently acted on a request to provide more flexibility in allowing guests to accompany a single member at Newcomers events.

#### Our Bylaws state:

"A guest of a member may attend a maximum of two meetings/functions, accompanied by that member, provided any event fees are paid by or on behalf of the guest. The spouse of an LN member cannot be considered a guest."

The above section of the Bylaws will not change. However, the Board agreed to create a brand-new membership status to cover guests accompanying a current member who is single. This addition to the Bylaws reads as follows:

"Single members (those without a spouse/partner) will be allowed to pay for an unnamed, associated guest membership which allows the single member to bring a guest to club events. The guest membership shall be associated with a specific single member. The guest membership shall be subject to the normal annual dues charged to all members. Any fees associated with a specific event attended by a guest member will also be due, as it would be for any other attendee."

This change will allow those single members who pay for an annual guest membership to bring a guest of their choice to any Lakeway Newcomers event -- provided the guest also pays the fees that would be applicable to the given event. The Board is hopeful that this change will further encourage Lakeway *Singles* to join or continue their membership in Lakeway Newcomers.
