Beerburg is locally owned with family ties to Lakeway. They offer a mix of on-site developed brews and a South Texas inspired taqueria. There is both indoor and expansive outdoor seating.

For the \$25 price of this event, we have arranged a flexible choice of beverage options to accommodate individual attendee preferences. Additionally, Beerburg will provide some light appetizers and a group tour of the brewery.

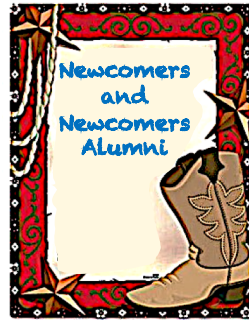
