### **New Activity Group**



We are introducing a new activity group for our members who ride e-bikes. This group will be hosted by Brian Hill, who also hosts the YouTube series "Seniors Guide to Buying an e-Bike."

An inaugural event will be held at **9:00 AM on Tuesday, June 6**. This first e-bike group ride will be a guided tour around the Lakeway area that will last approximately one hour. The tour will start at the Veterans Memorial in the Heritage Center parking lot, at the corner of Lohman's Crossing and Hurst Creek Rd. The ride will be of easy to moderate difficulty, on low or no traffic routes.

To participate, you must be an adult and own, or have access to, your own e-bike, and know how to proficiently ride. Your bike must be fully charged (it will be checked), and you must wear a helmet. Participation in this activity is at your own risk.

Our event will feature five wines accompanied by individual charcuterie boards. The Lead Sommelier and Vineyard Manager will discuss the featured wines and winery operations. The cost for this event is \$35 per person.

### Cinema Group

Attendees will bring an appetizer to share in addition to bringing their own beverage of choice. The host will provide or request some attendees to bring desserts. The evening begins with a half-hour social time beginning at 6:30, followed at 7:00 by a group discussion of the three movies. A dessert break occurs between the group discussion and the nomination of the next month's movies. The movie nominations will include a mix of in-theater and video streaming options. The entire group is then given a few days to vote on the movies that will be selected from the nomination list. Registration for attending the next meeting can begin once the month's movie selection vote has been compiled and announced to the whole group. This process helps members decide whether they are willing to see at least two of the movies that will be discussed at the next meeting.

All group members take turns being the host. The host of the current month's meeting will set the attendance capacity for their home.
