We have introduced a new activity group for our members who ride e-bikes. This group is hosted by Brian Hill, who also hosts the YouTube series "Seniors Guide to Buying an e-Bike."

An event will be held at 8:00 AM on Saturday, July 22. This e-bike group ride will be a tour around the Lakeway area. The tour will start at the Veterans Memorial in the Heritage Center parking lot, at the corner of Lohman's Crossing and Hurst Creek Rd. The ride will be of easy to moderate difficulty, on low or no traffic routes.

To participate, you must be an adult and own, or have access to, your own e-bike, and know how to proficiently ride. Your bike must be fully charged (it will be checked), and you must wear a helmet. Participation in this activity is at your own risk.


