An event will be held at **8:00 AM on Saturday, August 19**. This ebike ride will be an unofficial tour of historic Lakeway. Along the way, we will discuss the creation of the Lakeway airstrip, the first Lakeway telephone, and the opening of the Lakeway Inn by Lady Bird Johnson and Governor John Connolly.

To participate, you must be an adult and own, or have access to, your own e-bike, and know how to proficiently ride. Your bike must be fully charged (it will be checked), and you must wear a helmet. Participation in this activity is at your own risk.
