In September, we will be trying something different. We are holding a Happy Hour meet-up at Oz. Tap House at 10601 Ranch Rd 2222, from 3:00 to 5:00 on Thursday, September 21.

Oz. Tap House offers a unique beverage experience that is made possible by technologies, a beverage service that is complemented by a variety of food items available from their in-house kitchen.

This setup is ideal for trying small samples of many different beverages. While most of the options are beers, there are also cider, wine, cocktail, and soft drink options. You are billed electronically according to how many ounces of each beverage you self-pour into a glass. You decide which beverages to sample and how much of each you want. You can go back to the tap wall as many times as you'd like. You can also purchase select snacks at happy hour prices, or order a whole meal, whatever your preference.

There is no cost to attend this event other than being responsible for your own beverage and food tabs. We do, however, need to have an accurate count of who will be attending.
