Dining Out Group

While the current Dining Out cycle is in progress, it's not too early to start thinking about the **next cycle, which will begin in August**. Dining Out is a great way to meet new friends in the Lakeway area!

The way it works: Couples/Singles are randomly paired into groups of 6~8 people. Each couple/single in the group coordinates the choice of a restaurant and a mutually agreed upon date for an evening of good food and stimulating conversation. Each couple/single pays their own bill. The following month, another restaurant is chosen and the process continues until all couples in the group have led in the choice of a restaurant. Meeting once a month, each cycle will typically last 4 to 5 months. Following a couple-month break, participants are randomly reassigned to a new group and the process repeats. There are 2 cycles per year (Feb - June and Aug - Dec). You may elect to cease participation between cycles, otherwise participants will automatically be reassigned for the following cycle. **The next cycle will run from August through December 2025**. If you are not currently a participant in this fun activity, you will be able to sign up for the next cycle beginning in April and through June 2025.

Watch for sign-up details in this newsletter in the coming months. Dining Out is a great way to meet new folks our the community and explore great dining opportunities in the area!

The Cinema Group normally meets at a member's home on the **fourth Friday of each month** to discuss and rate two previously selected movies. 

Umlauf Sculpture Garden

Our April event will be a private tour of the <u>Umlauf Sculpture Garden</u>, which opened in 1991 and is home to dozens of bronze and stone pieces given to the city of Austin by the noted 20th-century American sculptor Charles Umlauf. Umlauf was also a Life Drawing and Sculpture professor at the University of Texas Art Department. He taught at UT for 40 years, retiring as Professor Emeritus in 1981. The Garden is known for being one of the most picturesque settings in Austin.

We plan to select a place to <u>meet for lunch before the tour</u> for those who would like to do that. Details will be forthcoming when we have an idea of the size of our group. The tour will last about 50 minutes, and the Gardens are open until 4 PM. There will be an exhibit in the museum that you may want to see before you leave. It is entitled "Beyond the Bombshell: Farrah Fawcett" and will display never-before-seen items from the collection she bequeathed to the Blanton Museum of Art upon her death in 2009. Before becoming an international sex symbol, Fawcett studied art at UT in the late 1960s, and Umlauf was her favorite professor.
